Board of Directors Election Policy

1. Introduction

A Board of Directors governs the Peach City Community Radio Society and is elected at the Annual General Meeting in the fall.

2. Composition

The board consists of the following 7 positions:

Director	Term	Election Year
President	2 years	Even
Vice President	2 years	Even
Treasurer	2 years	Odd
Secretary	2 years	Odd
Director at Large	2 years	Even
Director at Large	2 years	Odd
Director at Large	2 years	Odd

3. Nominations

Nominations for Directorships should be received no later than 1 week prior to the AGM. Nominations should be sent to the designated Nomination Officer, who will report all nominations at the AGM. Nominations from the AGM floor are not encouraged, but may only proceed if ratified by a 2/3 majority of the membership present at an AGM.

4. Membership Requirements

Interested persons are encouraged to run for Directorships after the minimum membership requirements are met. To run for President, a member must have retained membership in good standing for a minimum of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the AGM in which they are running. For all other elected positions, a member must have retained membership in good standing for a minimum of 6 months immediately preceding the AGM in which they are running. Members without these requirements may proceed as long as the membership present at the AGM ratifies the nomination by a 2/3 majority.

5. Vacated Positions

A sitting Director may run for a new position at any AGM. Elections for any positions made vacant during an AGM will take place following elections for regularly scheduled positions, with all nominations requiring a 2/3 majority ratification by membership present at the AGM.

6. Consecutive Terms

A sitting Director may choose to run for a consecutive term in the same position at an AGM during which their term expires. Should a Director choose to run for the same position for more than 2 consecutive terms, the nomination may only proceed if it is ratified by a 2/3 majority of the membership present at the AGM.

7. Past President

A President exiting the Board of Directors is automatically appointed as a non-voting, ex-officio member of the Board of Directors for a term of 1 year past their retirement from the position of President.
